Western Washington University (WWU) is a mid-size, public university. The Office
of Admissions supports university recruitment and enrollment goals with an inhouse communications team that creates content and products for prospective
undergraduate students.

- Improved Admissions website accessibility score from 65 to 97/100 by
 evaluating the accessibility and quality assurance weekly using SiteImprove,
 identifying problems, and devising and implementing solutions.
- Increased the traffic to the Majors site (the 2nd most popular site at WWU, 245k page views and 158k visits per year) by 28% by redesigning the homepage and improving the user search experience. Time on page increased by 186.73% from 1:53 minutes to 5:24 minutes. Within 2 weeks of launch, 15 majors that never received traffic from Google began to and 68/72 majors saw >100% increase in active visitors to their pages.
- Project management change management: Evaluated multiple project management apps to find the best fit for our team; set up information architecture for all project types with automations, custom fields, and tags; and migrated all projects from Wrike to ClickUp. Wrote documentation and held training workshops for multiple teams at WWU. On average, our team now spends 30% less time on PM app upkeep.
- Launched a mobile-first undergraduate application with a personalized web portal for applicants which supported recruitment and enrollment goals through the pandemic and allowed admitted students to track their submitted materials and deadlines. WWU only saw a minimal decline in enrollment from fall 2019 to fall 2020 (-6% vs -17% statewide). WWU also rebounded better compared to national averages, and is currently on pace with pre-pandemic record-high (2019).
- Cut superfluous pages and content (reduced total pages from 240 to 180) after conducting a content audit of the Admissions website. Less pages simplified content governance, decreased time spent on quality assurance by 9%, and made the migration from Drupal 7 to 8 faster and easier to manage for our team.
